IN ORDER TO REGISTER FOR ALC CLASSES, you will need to have your parent sign this card, giving permission to take classes at the ALC, and then meet in-person with either your high school counselor or ALC counselor.

TAKING THE BUS TO THE ALC

Buses run to and from each high school (except for Salem Hills) before school, during lunch, and after school. However, buses from ALC after school, do not reach high schools in time for students to catch any connecting buses home. Students who normally take a bus home should choose ALC classes in our morning block or make plans for alternative transportation.

SELECT CLASSES IN MULTIPLES OF AT LEAST TWO. This allows for travel time between ALC and the primary school, as our bell schedules do not match. Classes with a college course number may be taken for CE college credit with a qualifying GPA. Academic courses require at least a 3.00 GPA and CTE courses require at least a 2.00 GPA.

- DISTANCE LEARNING (CHECK THE BOX IF INTERESTED and our ALC Counselor will get in touch with you.)** Each class is double blocked, meaning it will take up both your A/B periods in any given time slot. Live Interactive courses are broadcasted from UVU in real time to an ALC classroom taught by a UVU professor. Talk to the ALC or your high school counselor for more information.

ALC REGISTRATION STEPS

1. This form will need to be signed by both the parent and student. This allows the student to be dual enrolled in both schools in order to register for ALC courses.
2. Student then meets with their high school counselor or ALC counselor to discuss course options and turns in Registration Card.
3. **ALC ONLINE REGISTRATION** – Students who are dual enrolled into ALC will then be able to log onto Aspire and sign up for any ALC classes, on a first-come, first-serve basis. Classes will open in the following order:

- **Wed. March 20th** Seniors only
- **Thurs. March 21st** Juniors & Seniors
- **Mon. March 25th** Sophomores, Juniors, & Seniors
- **Tues. April 9th** Online ALC registration window closes to students at 11:55 pm
- **Wed. April 10th** From this date on, students will need to meet with their high school or the ALC counselor to add or make changes to any ALC course. Class changes will no longer be available online to students.
